Battle of the Bands Scheduled May 7

KEUKA PARK, N.Y.—Does your band have what it takes to wow college audiences?

Prove it at Keuka College's Battle of the Bands May 7 from 2-9 p.m. on the Norton Chapel lawn.

The first place winner will receive a trophy and be guaranteed a paid performance (\$500) at the College during the fall 2005 semester. The group might also have the opportunity to open for a nationally touring act that will perform at Keuka next year. The second place winner will receive a trophy and be guaranteed a paid performance (\$250) at the College during the spring 2006 semester, while the third place winner will also receive a trophy and a guaranteed paid performance (\$125) in the spring semester. All participating bands will receive a certificate of participation.

Applications will be accepted until April 25. Four to eight bands will be selected to perform based on the application and an accompanying press kit, which should include a CD, band picture, history of the band, and three references or letters of recommendation. All finalists must send one representative to attend a Battle of the Bands information meeting at the College (specific location yet to be determined) Wednesday, May 4 at 7 p.m.

The Battle of the Bands is one of many events scheduled at the College for Spring Weekend. It is sponsored by the Campus Activities Board (CAB), the Class of 2006, and the student activities office.
