Daggett to Serve on Board of Directors For National Student Employment Association

KEUKA PARK, N.Y.—Sally Daggett, associate director of experiential education at Keuka College, was elected to serve a two-year term on the Board of Directors for the National Student Employment Association (NSEA).

The National Student Employment Association is an organization of several hundred professionals involved with programs for college student employment. Membership is open to anyone with an interest in administering student employment or hiring students. NSEA supports and promotes student employment through research, publications, professional development opportunities, and the open exchange of information.

Effective January 2005, Daggett will assume the role of vice president of administration for the NSEA and will be responsible for the organization's online directory, election policies and procedures, and manual and bylaws. She will also oversee the historian and volunteer efforts.

"It is a great honor to have been elected," said Daggett, a Penn Yan resident and member of the NSEA since 1995. "At the regional level, the board makes recommendations on who should represent their organization at the national level. The regional board has the confidence in me to be that liaison between both boards and I am looking forward to the challenge. I am proud to represent Keuka College and the Northeast Association of Student Employment Administrators on the Board of Directors for the national Student Employment Association."

Daggett is a former board member for the Northeast Association of Student Employment Administrators, "which allowed me to share the great things Keuka was doing at a regional level."

"I can now go the next step and share Keuka's achievements at the national level," said Daggett. "[Serving on the national board] is also a chance to learn even more about student employment from colleagues across the United States."

Daggett's first board meeting is scheduled for February in San Diego, Calif.
