Lightner Gallery to Showcase Works by Don Sottile

KEUKA PARK, N.Y.—*Body Language*, an exhibit of drawings and sculpture by Don Sottile, will be on display in Keuka College's Lightner Gallery Jan. 26-March 4.

An artist reception is scheduled Feb. 20 from 2-4 p.m. The reception and exhibition are free and open to the public.

Sottile earned a bachelor's degree in art from SUNY Buffalo. The Dresden resident also studied at the University of Siena and the School of Fine Art in Siena, Italy.

Sottile, a Westfield native, taught and worked at Brockport Middle School, Lake Country Woodworkers, and Rochester Institute of Technology. He worked and taught with Scottsville sculptor Wendell Castle for 21 years.



In addition to previous Lightner Gallery exhibits, Sottile's work has been shown at Rochester's Memorial Art Gallery, the Schweinfurth Memorial Art Center in Auburn, the Nazareth Art Center in Pittsford, the National Sculpture Society in New York City, the Chautauqua Institution, and the Oxford Gallery in Rochester.

The gallery is located in the Lightner Library. Gallery hours are Monday-Thursday from 8 a.m.-11 p.m.; Friday, 8 a.m.-6 p.m.; Saturday, 8:30 a.m.-6 p.m.; and Sunday, noon-11 p.m.
