Pumpkin Roll Contest Scheduled Oct. 31

KEUKA PARK, N.Y.—You've probably picked a pumpkin, carved or painted a pumpkin, maybe even smashed a pumpkin, but have you ever rolled a pumpkin in competition?

If not, there's a first time for everything.

And that time is Sunday, Oct. 31.

That's when Keuka College's Pumpkin Roll Contest is scheduled to take place on the Norton Chapel Lawn. The event is free and open to the public.



The senior contest, for those age 55 and older, will begin at 4 p.m.; the kids contest, for those ages 5-15 (broken down into brackets of five years and younger, ages 6-10, and ages 11-15), will begin at 5 p.m.; and the Keuka College student contest, pinning class against class, will begin at 6:30 p.m.

Pumpkin rolling is similar to bowling, but instead of knocking down pins, the object is to get one's pumpkin closest to the finish line without going over the side foul lines.

Prizes will be awarded to the first, second and third place winners, as well as the overall winner, in each contest bracket.

Registration forms are available on campus in the Office of Student Activities (Dahlstrom Student Center) and at various Penn Yan locations. The registration deadline is Friday, Oct. 29.

The event, planned to continue annually, is sponsored by Keuka College's Campus Activities Board (CAB), the Class of 2006, the Class of 2007, and the Office of Student Activities.
