Haydn and Hendrix Come Together In Feb. 21 Concert

KEUKA PARK, N.Y. - Quartsemble, a Rochester-based chamber music group, will perform at Keuka College Monday, Feb. 21 at 7 p.m. in Norton Chapel.

Part of Keuka College's Spotlight Series, the concert is free and open to the public.

The group will perform a mix of such classical favorites as Haydn, Debussy, and Vivaldi, with the rock 'n' roll of Jimmy Hendrix.

The group showcases the talents of:

- Violinist Karine Stone performs in the second violin section of the Rochester Philharmonic Orchestra and is an active freelance and chamber musician. She has performed with the Schlossfestspiel Orchestra in Heidelberg, Germany; and the Syracuse Symphony Orchestra. An acting concertmaster of the Erie Philharmonic, Stone serves as conductor of the Cobblestone Chamber Orchestra.
- Violinist Heidi Brodwin has toured nationally and internationally with such orchestras as the New World Symphony and the Charleston Symphony, and has performed in the Spoleto Music Festival. While a member of the Charleston Symphony Orchestra, Brodwin visited classrooms and demonstrated different instruments and types of music. She is a member of the Syracuse Symphony Orchestra and teaches privately.
- Violist Kirsten Swanson has participated in such chamber music festivals as Sorbonne, Brevard Music Center, Garth Newel Chamber Festival, and the Aspen Music Festival, where she was awarded the Bertel M. Lewis fellowship.
- Cellist Diego Garcia has toured Germany, Austria, France, Italy and Central America as a chamber musician, recording artist, orchestral player, and soloist. He has played under the direction of such renowned conductors as Kurt Masur, Zened Mackal and Sergiu Commissiona, and performed at Carnegie Hall and Lincoln Center.

The husband-wife team of Stone and Garcia formed the group.
