### ***Girl Art on Display in Lightner Gallery***

KEUKA PARK, N.Y. — *Girl Art*, a traveling solo show of painting, bronze sculpture and mixed media by Rochester artist Belinda Bryce, will be on display in Keuka College's Lightner Library Gallery Feb. 20-March 24.



An artist's reception will be held Sunday, March 12 from 2 - 4 p.m. in the Lightner Gallery. The Gallery is open Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. The exhibit and the reception are free and open to the public.

Bryce serves as program coordinator of Rochester Institute of Technology (RIT)'s School of Art. A graduate of RIT, Bryce earned degrees in printmaking and painting.

Bryce's work has appeared in both national and international juried shows including the Dakotas International Exhibition of Artwork on Paper, the *Inner Voices: Searching for the Conscious Feminine* exhibit in Chicago, the North American Printmaking Exhibition in California, and the LaGrange National XIX Biennial in Georgia.

Closer to home, Bryce has exhibited at Rochester's Gallery 15, the Tyler Art Gallery at SUNY Oswego and the Adams Art Gallery in Dunkirk. Her works have been featured in the Rochester-Finger Lakes Exhibitions, as well as the Women's Art Works V National Exhibition sponsored by the Women's Foundation of the Genesee Valley.

Her honors include a Juror's Choice Award in the Rochester-Finger Lakes Exhibition and the Memorial Art Gallery's Patron Print Award.
