Lightner Gallery Showcases Work By Geneva Resident, 2005 Graduate



KEUKA PARK, N.Y.—*Along the Way*, a collection of drawings and paintings by 2005 Keuka College alumnus Brian Palmieri, is on display in the College’s Lightner Library Gallery Jan. 2-30.

The Lightner Gallery is open Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. The exhibit is free and open to the public.

Palmieri describes the show as a mix of works from his four-year College career as a visual and verbal art major. In addition to drawings and paintings, a sculpture, some poetry and photographs are also included.

Palmieri, a December graduate, created the art exhibit to fulfill the requirements for his senior project.

“His show sets the benchmark higher for other students to follow suit,” said Associate Professor of Art and Director of the Lightner Gallery Dexter Benedict. “It shows the growth that he’s made in the last couple of years and his potential as an artist.”

According to Palmieri, some of the works are “realistic snapshots of what I’ve seen, things people would recognize. Other pieces are more abstract and contain symbols that are meaningful to me. The symbolic ones are the more recent pieces.”
