Britannica Online

- Search Encyclopaedia Britannica online

BioOne

- BioOne™ is an aggregation of full text articles from research journals focusing on the biological, ecological and environmental sciences.

EBSCOHost

- **Academic Search Premier:** Provides full text for nearly 4,650 scholarly publications covering academic areas of study including social sciences, humanities, education, computer sciences, engineering, language and linguistics, arts & literature, medical sciences, and ethnic studies.
- **Business Source Premier:** Provides full text for nearly 8,800 journals covering business, management, economics, finance, banking, accounting, and much more.
- **Clinical Pharmacology:** Contains drug monographs for U.S. prescription drugs and over-the-counter products.
- **ERIC:** Educational Resource Information Center database, contains citations and abstracts from over 980 educational and education-related journals, as well as full text of more than 2,200 digests.
- **Health Source: Nursing/Academic Edition:** Provides over 550 scholarly full text journals focusing on many medical disciplines
- **MEDLINE:** Allows users to search of abstract of more than 4800 periodicals in the fields of medicine, nursing, dentistry, veterinary medicine, the health care system, pre-clinical sciences, and much more.
- **Newspaper Source:** Provides selected full text articles from 200 U.S. and international newspapers.
- **Professional Development Collection:** Provides a highly specialized collection of nearly 550 full text journals, designed for professional educators.
- **PsycARTICLES:** Full text of 46 journals published by the American Psychological Association and allied organizations

EDRS

ERIC Document Reproduction Service. Many ERIC documents available in full-text online.

FirstSearch

- **ArticleFirst:** An OCLC index of articles from over 12,000 journals.
- **ERIC** or the Educational Resources Information Center: A clearinghouse of education information. ERIC is created by the U. S. Department of Education and contains references on thousands of educational topics. Updated monthly.
- **MEDLINE:** see description under EBSCOHost
- **WilsonSelect Plus:** Full text articles in science, humanities, education and business
- **World Almanac:** Fundamental reference resources
- **World Cat:** Over 38 million records to books and other materials that could be borrowed through ILL.

Infotrac

- **Health Reference Center:** The full text of respected nursing, allied health, and medical journals; consumer health magazines; reference books; newsletters; pamphlets; newspaper articles; topical overviews
- **Business and Company Resource Center:** Company profiles, brand information, rankings, investment reports, company histories, chronologies and periodicals.
- **Custom Newspapers:** Search this database of 150 national and international papers.
- **New York State Newspapers:** Search this database of 10 major newspapers published in New York State.

Infotrac (cont.)

- **National Newspaper Index:** Provide quick access to 5 top national newspapers.
- **Twayne's Author Series:** Contains 600 full text titles on individual World, US, or English authors.

Lexis/Nexis

Fulltext articles in the areas of news, business, legal research, medical and reference.

Literary Reference Center

Rich in biographical, bibliographical, and critical content. A resource for information on literary figures from all time periods writing in such genres as fiction, nonfiction, poetry, drama, history, journalism, and more.

Mergents

Suite of information resources that enable in-depth business and financial research.

Newsbank

Full text of regional newspapers online

PerSearch Databases

These databases use the same interface as FirstSearch.

- **Books In Print:** Bibliographic resource for in print, out-of-print, and forthcoming books
- **PAIS:** Public Affairs Information Service database
- **PsycFIRST:** Articles, books, dissertations, and reports on psychology

Proquest

- **ABI/Inform:** These databases cover business, finance, economics, and industry
- **Proquest Health Management:** Covers administrative aspects of medical industry, including insurance, finance, labor and laws
- **Proquest Newspapers:** Covers 27 national newspapers, including New York Times and Wall Street Journal
- **Research Library:** Covers a broad range of social sciences, science, humanities and law

Silverplatter

- **Cumulative Index to Nursing and Allied Health Literature (CINAHL):** Provides indexing for over 500 journals in the fields of nursing and allied health.
- **Peterson's College Database:** Contains over 3,600 profiles of accredited baccalaureate and associate degree-granting institutions in the United States and Canada.
- **Social Work Abstracts:** Contains information on the fields of social work and human services from 1977 to present. The database provides exceptional coverage of more than 450 journals in all areas of the profession, including theory and practice, areas of service, social issues, and social problems.

Xrefplus

- Online 100 volume collection dictionaries, encyclopedias, handbooks and other reference works
